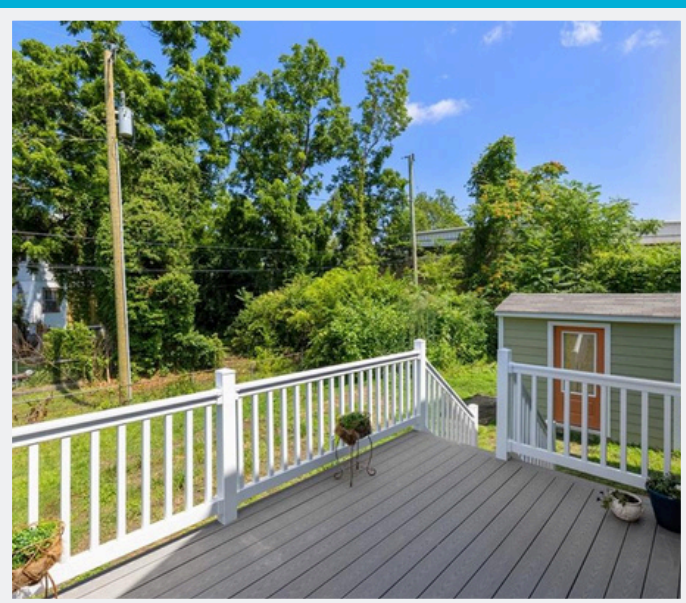

Richmond Metropolitan Habitat for Humanity is committed to making affordable and safe housing a reality for families in our community.

OUR IMPACT

Since 1986, we have built and rehabbed nearly **400** homes in the Greater Richmond area. We have completed more than **175** critical home repairs.

In fiscal year 2024, we served a total of **52** families through our Homeownership, Home Repairs, Affordable Open Market Homes, Affordable Rentals, and Tithe programs. We mobilized **2,194** unique volunteers to fill **6,063** volunteer spots for a total of **34,061** service hours.

FAMILIES SERVED in FY24

Homeownership

Habitat homeowners complete 10 homeownership education classes and 350 hours of "sweat equity" or volunteer time on and then purchase their home with an affordable mortgage.

FY24: 11 homeowners served

Home Repairs

In this program, we help those in the community who need assistance with critical home repairs.

FY24: 33 homeowners served

Affordable Open Market Homes

This program offers reasonably priced homes to individuals who make 80% area median Income or less and qualify for their own mortgage.

FY24: 4 homeowners served

Heat Pump (8.5 HSPF / 15 SEER / 12 EER)

Windows (U-factor: 0.30 / SHGC: 0.40)

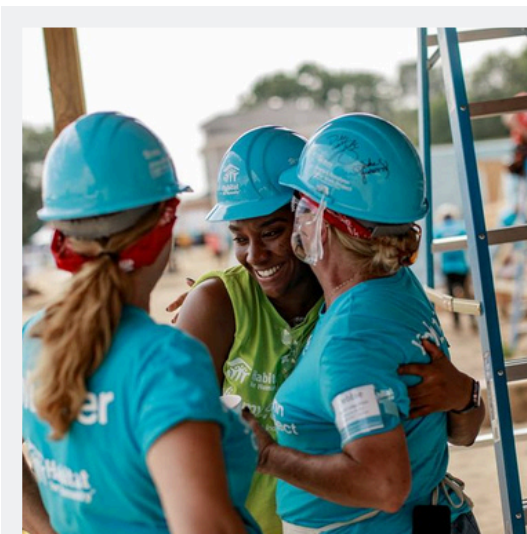
